

SUPPLIER- Macadamia Nut- in- Shell Specification

Product Description:

- The product contains Australian Macadamia Nut in Shell (NIS) from the current harvest season.
- NIS should be more than 18mm in diameter at its widest axis.
- NIS should be out of husk.
- NIS should be clean, free of smell/ odour, live infestation, contamination, foreign matter, and allergens (and other extraneous matter).

Delivery Specifications:

All NIS will be subject to visual inspection upon delivery.

Visual inspection will be undertaken to ensure the NIS meets “Product Description” criteria as set out in this document.

Foreign materials include, but are not limited to:

- Materials that do not grow on the macadamia tree or are not found on the orchard floor (rubber, metal, plastics).
- Leaves
- Sticks
- Rocks
- Dirt
- Animal carcasses

NIS Should be generally free from the following visual defects:

- Black nuts
- Loose shell
- Loose kernel
- Rodent damaged nuts
- Large cracks
- Mechanical damage
- Germination
- Nut borer damage
- Spotting bug damage
- Surface mould
- Abnormal colouration

The vehicle used to transport NIS should be free from smell, odour, live infestation, contamination, other foreign matter, and evidence of previous cargo, allergens, damage, and anything that could compromise the NIS safety and may be detrimental to the visual appearance and quality of the NIS.

Deliveries that do not meet the specifications may be rejected.
